- Clothing Bank: Located at 18B, Shri Kalyan Nagar, Kartarpura, the bank operates in a free 1100-square-foot basement provided by the founder president, Dr. Daulat Ram Malya.
- Distribution: Donors contribute clothes, and social workers or organizations can issue and distribute clothing to the needy.

Additionally, a book bank operates alongside, offering donated books and stationery to students, further enhancing educational access and support.
